

## Get involved and "WIN"

Parent participation is highly encouraged in all CDC programs, and is actually necessary for some activities to be successful. There would not be special events, tours, and classroom activities without the dedication of volunteer. Some ways parents participate in child care programs may include eating lunch with their child and participating in various room activities (prior arrangements must be made with your child's teacher). Parent Teacher Organization operates to support the Center and summer camp is open to all parents. Through the PTO, parents provide valuable input to the programs in which their children spend a significant portion of their day. encourage parent participation, the "Why I'm Needed" (WIN) program allows parents to earn points through volunteering opportunities at the centers, or attending Parent teachers Organization meetings.

The WIN Program: This is a special program that enables parents to earn up to a 10% discount on their 1st child's monthly child care fees at the CDC. Parents performing essential tasks for the CDC earn a specific number of discount credits. Each discount credits is worth 1 percent each up to a maximum of 10 discount points which is 10%. These credit points may then be applied towards monthly child care fee. Check with the CDC Director, Assistant Director, or front desk staff for more information. Parents must have background checks completed prior to being accepted in "WIN" program.



**Assemble Items for a Prop Box -1 Credit**

Assemble dramatic play items from a list provided by the center. Props such as those for housekeeping and transportation facilitate learning by encouraging children to manipulate objects, communicate with each other, and solve problems. Assembling on prop box will earn one credit point.

**Accompany a CDC on a Field Trip -1 credit**

Staff will notify you about field trip opportunities both on and off center. Accompanying group on a field trip will earn one credit.

**Complete the CDC survey - 1 Credit**

Parents that return periodic surveys of the CDC will receive one credit point.



**Become a CDC Volunteer—1 Credit**

Parents participating as often as once a week at the center receive volunteer training and under-go health and background checks. Each person completing enrollment as a program volunteer will receive one credit.



**Attend a PTO Meeting— 1 to 5 credits**

Receive updates on all CDC programs, children's activities, and parenting information. Each family represented at a Parent Teacher Organization meeting will receive one credit. Serve as an PTO officer for 6 months and receive up to 5 credit or serve as project chair to earn 3 points.

**Attend a Child Development Services  
Approved Class—1 Credit**



Enhance your parenting skills by attending a class offered by CDC or PTO receive 1 credit for each class.

**Assist with Activity classroom or CDC  
maintenance—1 to 2 Credits**

Help the center with chores such as washing easels, sewing curtains, repairing dramatic play clothes or assembling toys, furniture or equipment. The will periodically provide a list of maintenance requirements. Depending on the assignment, volunteers may receive 1 to two credit.



**Read or record stories, Make  
folder games or Flannel Boards Sto-  
ries—1 credit**



You will receive materials, instructions, and a list of needed games and stories. The center will provide blank tapes and a selection of stories for the parent to record. Three completed games or stories will earn 1 credit.

**Assist with Nap Time - 1  
credit**



Pat Backs, read, hum, or sing soothing tunes to help children relax during nap time. The extra attention make it a relaxing, enjoyable time for all children. Each visit must be a minimum of 45 minutes. Two assist will earn 1 credit.

**Assist with Family Style Dining—1 credit**

Join your child's classroom or activity room for breakfast or lunch. For credit, you must arrive to help with hand washing and stay through clean up. Please schedule visits in advance.

**Assist with Special Events— 1 credit**

Throughout the year, the Center and PTO holds special events which are enhanced by volunteer assistance. Examples of special events include Open House, Annual Day of Caring, fall, holiday or spring parties, seasonal pictures, as well as others as approved by the Center Director. Assistance at special events will earn 1 credit.
